Show Rules & Regulations – PLEASE READ!!

All Horses and Ponies must be registered with AIHR to participate in this show and with HOA to be eligible for HOA awards. Horses can be registered prior to or during the show and will then be able to compete. A Show Rules & Regulations Sheet is provided with Show Packets. Show Rules are in place for the safety of all contestants, for fairness and equality to all entrants, and help with needed time constraints of the Show. Please be sure that you have a copy of the R & R and understand them as stated. Show Officials will answer any questions that you may have regarding these Rules.

Texas State law requires that each horse must have proof of a negative Coggins test. Paperwork must accompany entry form.

Riders 7 & under in Papoose Classes may be on lead line or accompanied by an adult on foot. If a Papoose is led through an event, *it must be with a halter and lead line throughout the entire class.* A bridle maybe placed over the halter for the rider to use as well. **In speed events, all handlers of Papoose horses should note that the horse must break the timer line both coming and going. For the handler to break the timer either coming in or going out represents a disqualification**
